Background

The purpose of this meeting is to update the claim group and take instructions on matters relating to the Tjalkadjara native title claim (WAD 597 of 2018).

NTS Goldfields (NTSG) staff, David Lanagan, Trinity Handley, Nicole Casley and Daniel Jacobs will be attending. Michael Pagsanjan of MPS Law, who is currently assisting NTSG with the claim, will also attend.

PURPOSE:

1. **Update** on the progress of the Tjalkadjara Claim, and the appointment of NTSG to provide legal representation for the claim; and
2. To **consider, discuss and make decisions about** the mediation with the Waturta native title claim (WAD 297/2018), including the nomination of a maximum of ten (10) Tjalkadjara claim group members to represent the claim at a mediation with Waturta in Kalgoorlie on 21-23 March. 2023.
3. **General Business/close meeting**

Members of the Tjalkadjara Claim are invited to attend. Persons who are members of the Tjalkadjara claim are those persons included in the following claim group description:

The claim group comprises those Aboriginal people who satisfy one or more of the following criteria:

(1) have rights in the area covered by the application (Claim Area) on the basis of descent from ancestors who held rights in the Claim Area under traditional law and custom at the time of the acquisition of British sovereignty, which includes the descendants of one or more of the following identified pre-contact ancestors:

- a. Wunu and his wife Biyuwara (Bidly);
- b. Narangkatu (father of Biman, Thati and Dinah);
- c. Pangu (father of Scotty Lewis);
- d. Annie Green Tuteru / Tuthara;
- e. Tom Wunal;
- f. Sambo / Tjampu (father of Nuna);
- g. Billy (husband of Mary Ann, the parents of Daisy Cordella and others);
- h. Tharin and his wife Ruby Daga (parents of Nguldard Jim Hennesey and others);
- i. Maude Yarlyen;
- j. Lily Wongawol;
- k. Ngaratarikartaly Nellie Warren her husband Munggi Munggi and other husband Ngawila;
- l. Turuda Skipper Sandy;
- m. Paddy Tjintarti;

(2) have rights in the Claim Area on the basis of descent from ancestors who acquired rights in the Claim Area under traditional law and custom as a result of post-sovereignty migration into, and long association with, the Claim Area, which includes the descendants of one or more of the following ancestors:

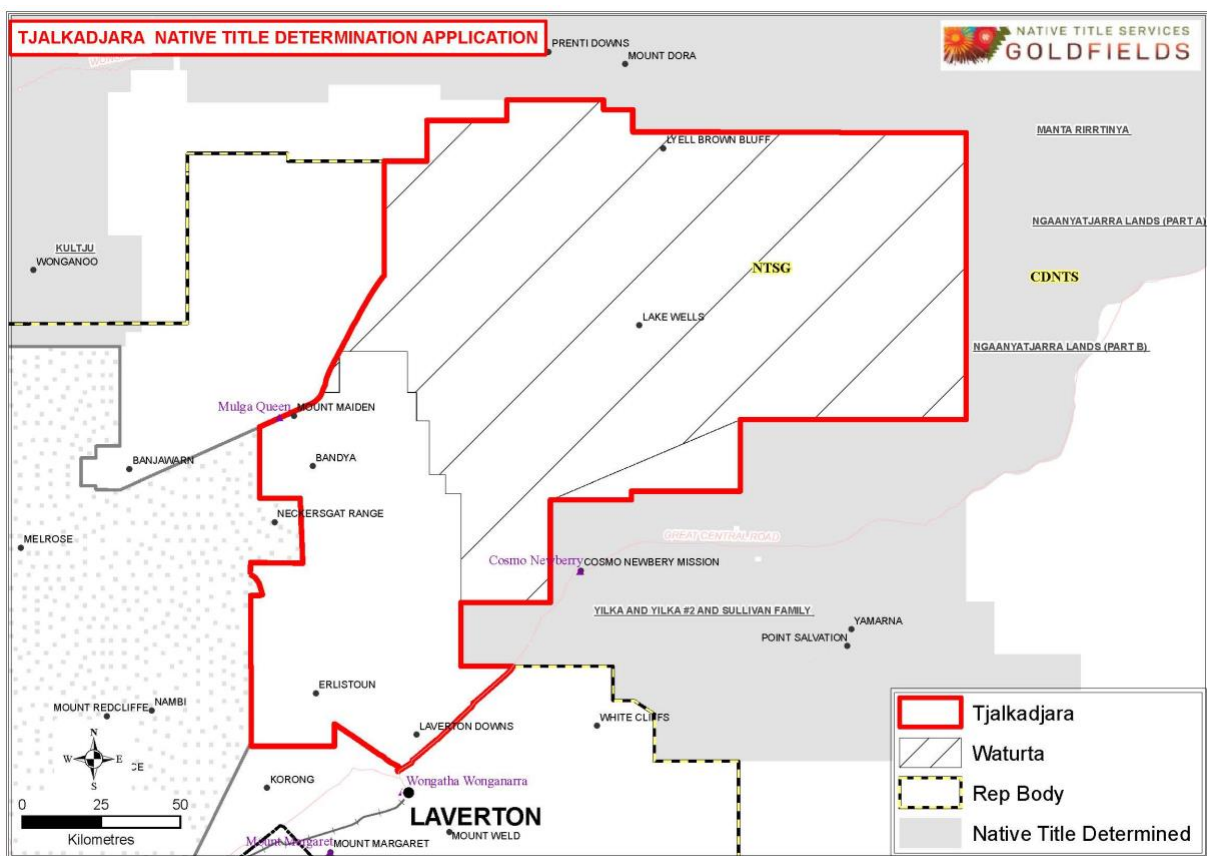

- d. Daphne Munroe;

(4) have religious, sacred or ritual authority under traditional law and custom for places within the Claim Area

Travel Assistance

A contribution of **up to \$400** will be paid to members of the claim group who attend the meeting from elsewhere. The maximum travel allowance will only be paid to those people who attend the meeting from a distance further than 500kms.
