This variously includes conducting your own research, reviewing and supporting consultant anthropologists in regard to ethnographic research and analysis of law and custom, and rights and interests in land, and group decision making. Other responsibilities include:

- Providing advice about client and stakeholder engagement;
- Lead, manage and supervise the progress of tasks in accordance with approved project plans.
