Under section 30(1)(a) of the Act, persons have until 3 months after the notification day to take certain steps to become native title parties in relation to the notice. The 3-month period closes on **26/06/2025**. Any person who is, or becomes a native title party, is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2 Division 3 Subdivision P of the Act.

If there is no native title party at the end of the four months after the notification day (i.e. **26/07/2025**) then the mining lease/s may be renewed.

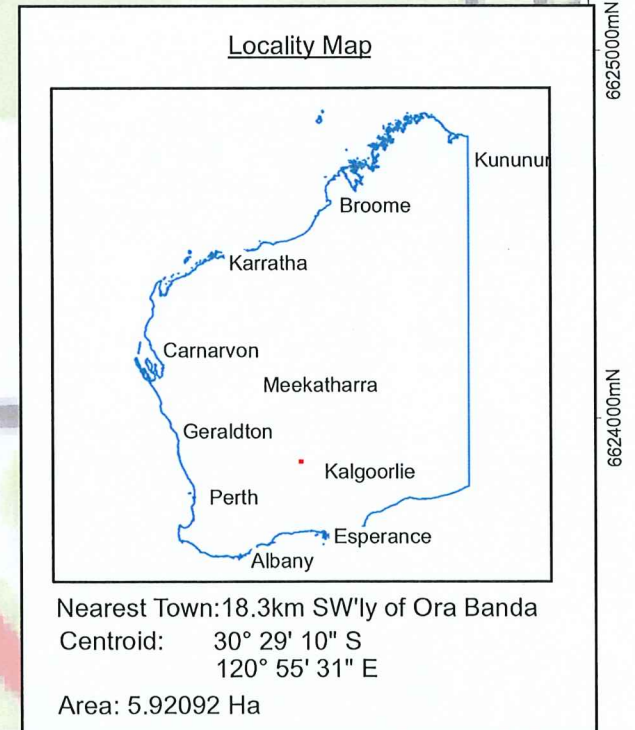
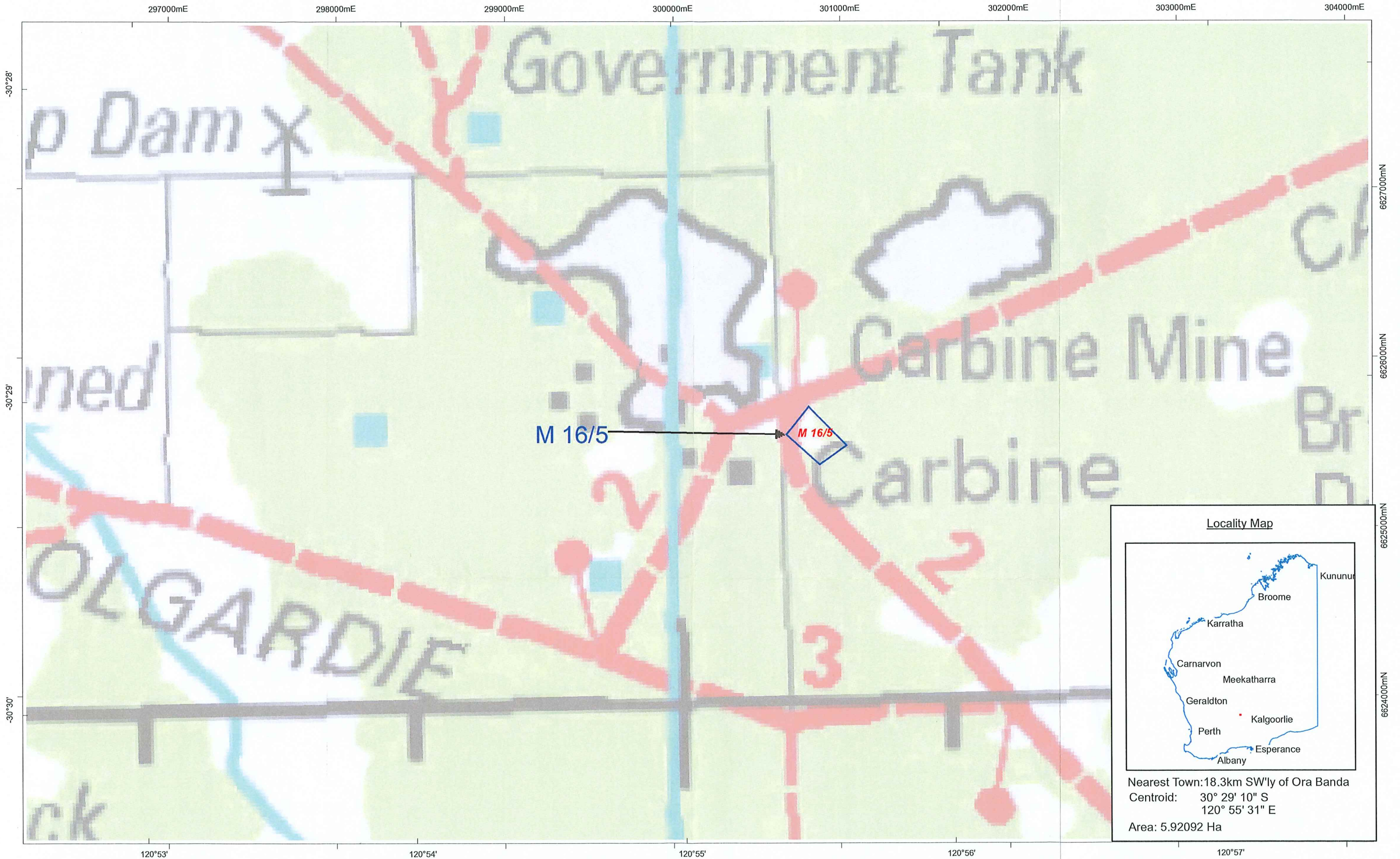

**Nature of the act:** The renewal of mining lease, which authorises the applicant to mine for minerals for a term of up to 21 years.

**Notification day:** 26 March 2025

**Native title parties:** Under section 30 of the *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)*, persons have until three months after the notification day to take certain steps to become native title parties in relation to the notice. The three month period closes on **26 June 2025**. Any person who is, or becomes a native title party, is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2 Division 3 Subdivision P of *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)*.
