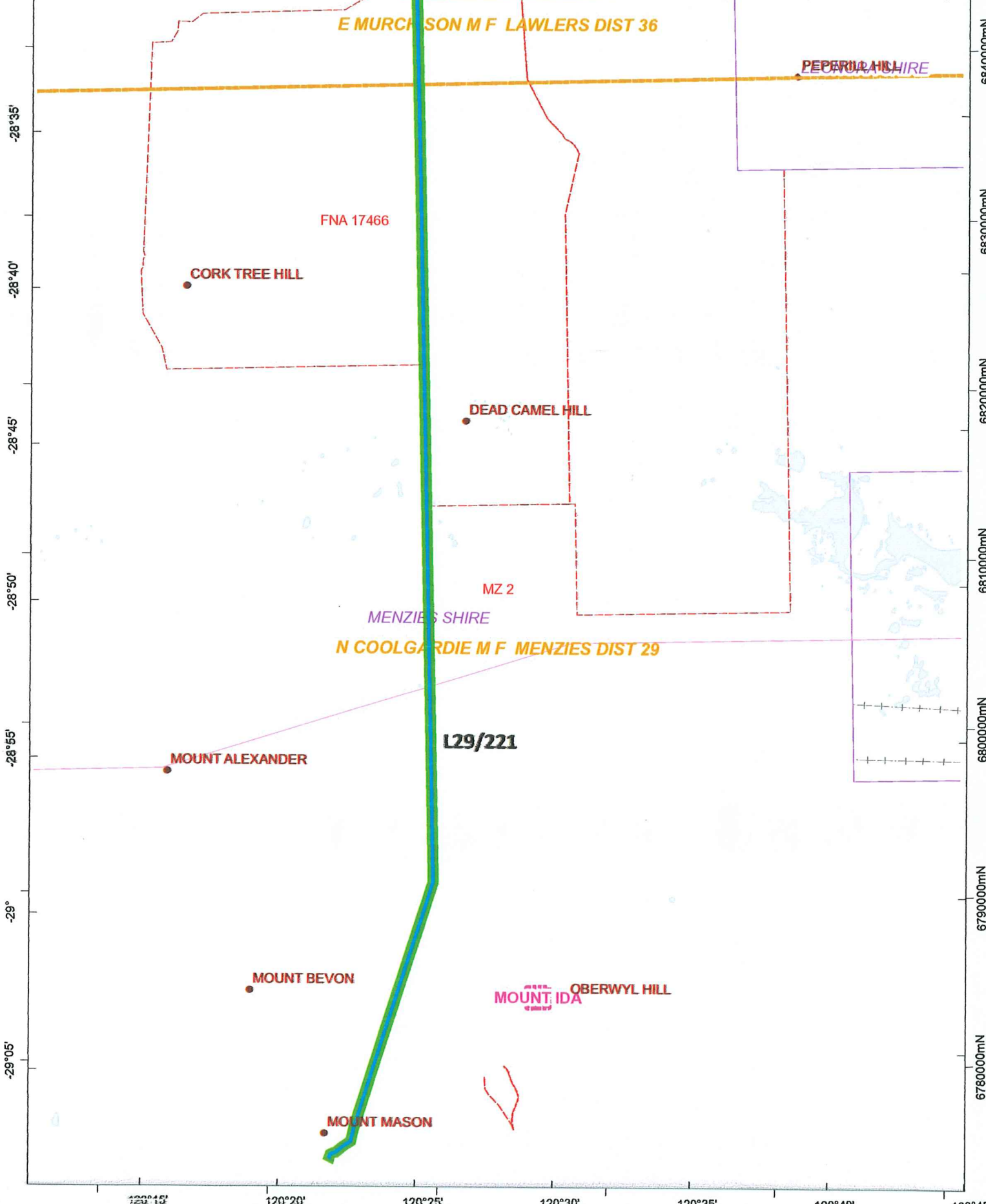


Pending Application
