If there is no native title party at the end of the four months after the notification day then the lease/licence application/s may be granted.

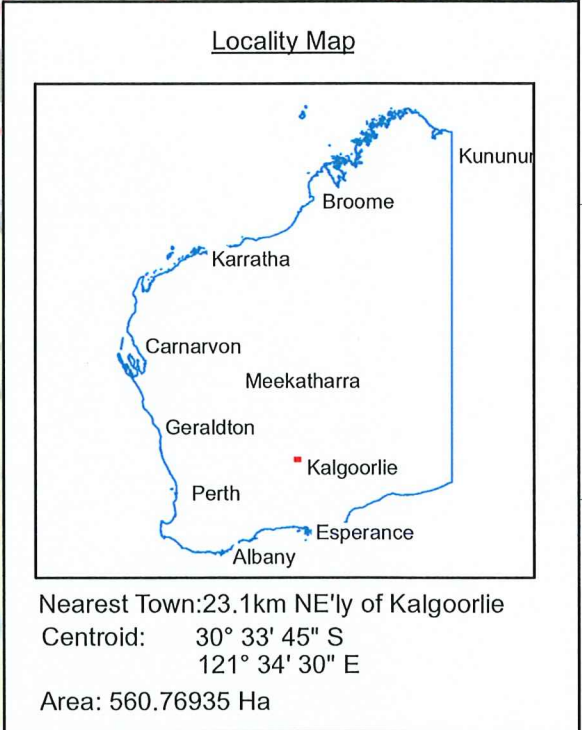
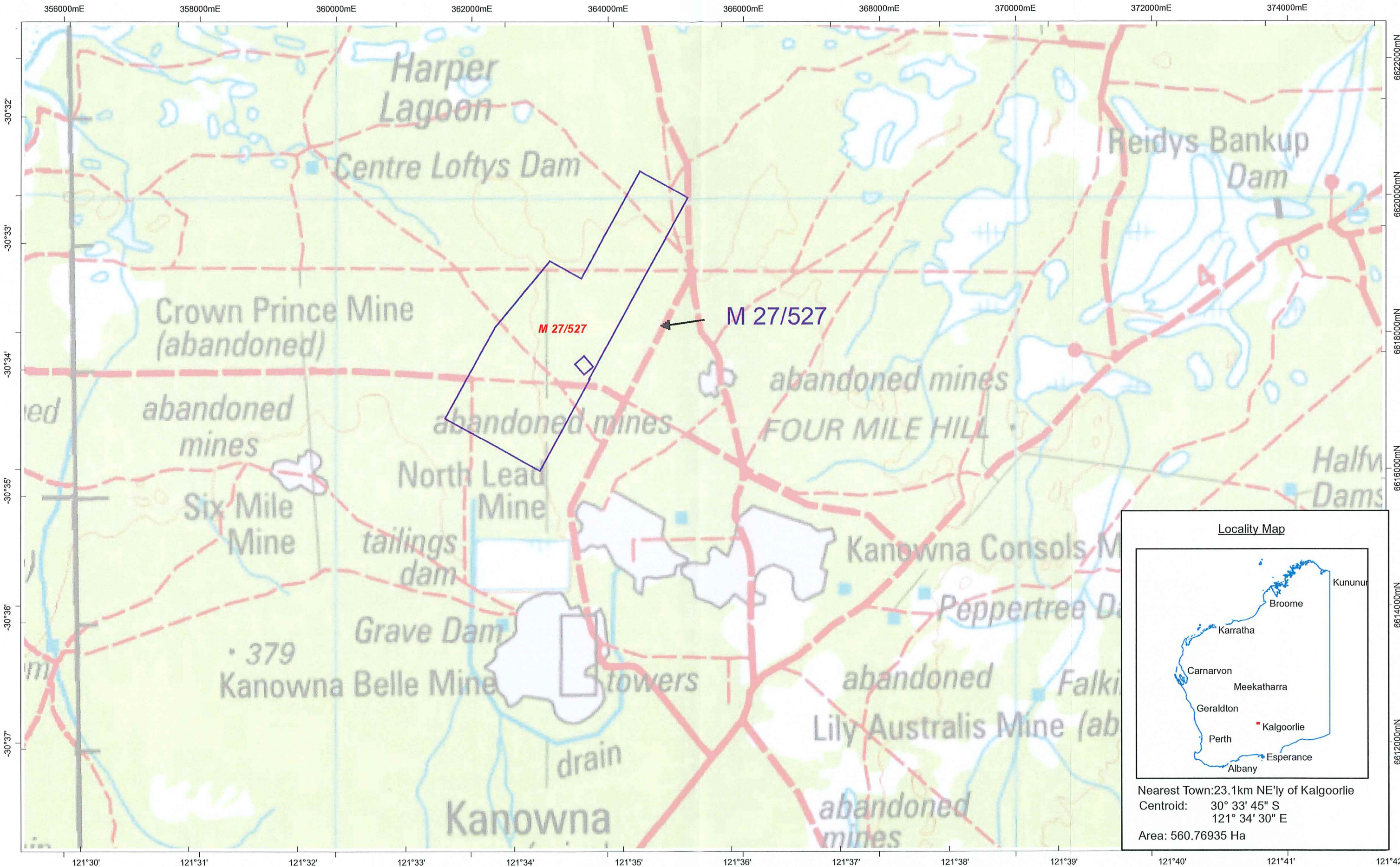

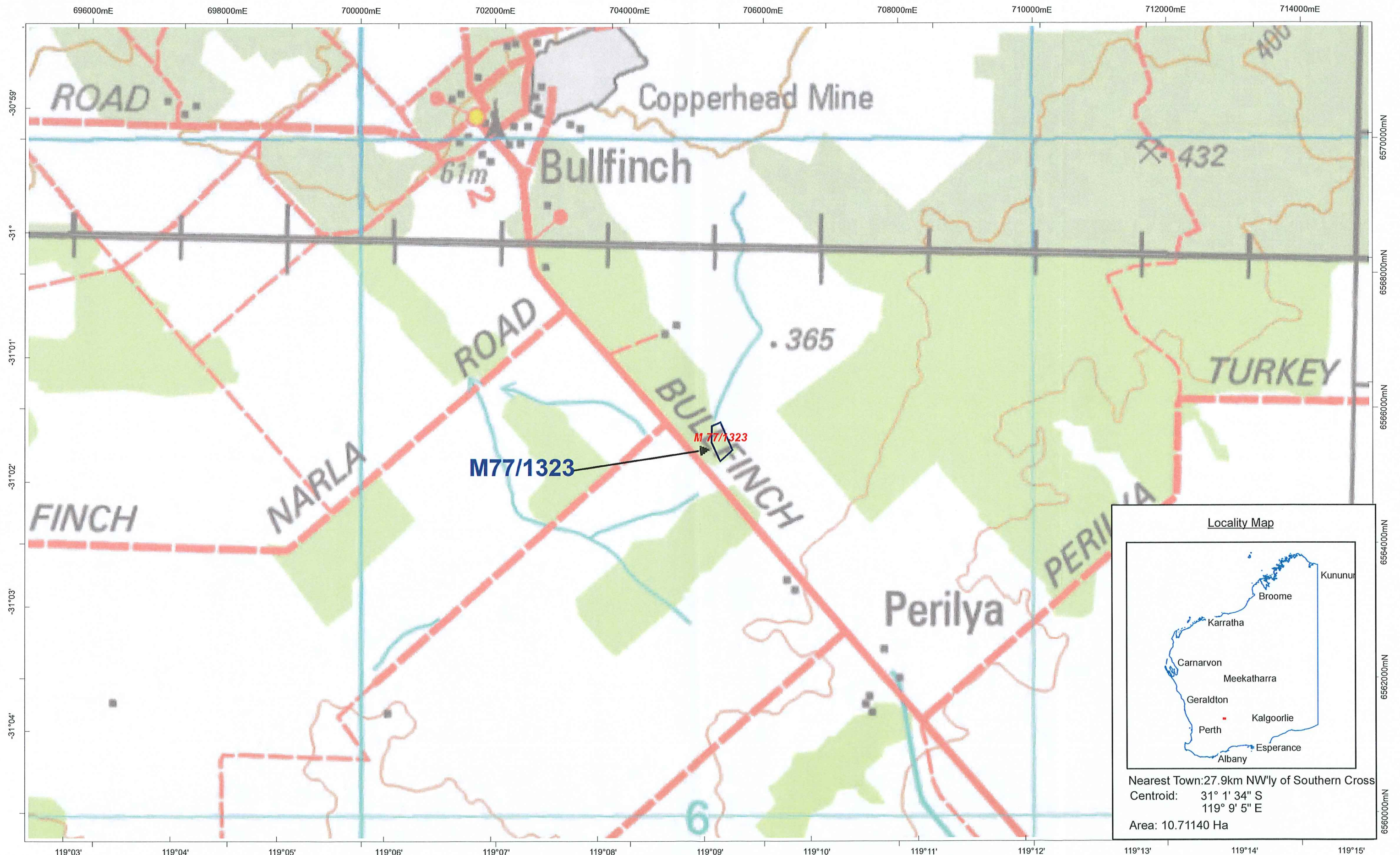


GDA 1994 MGA Zone 50

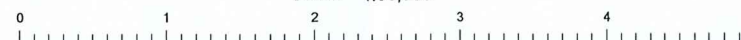

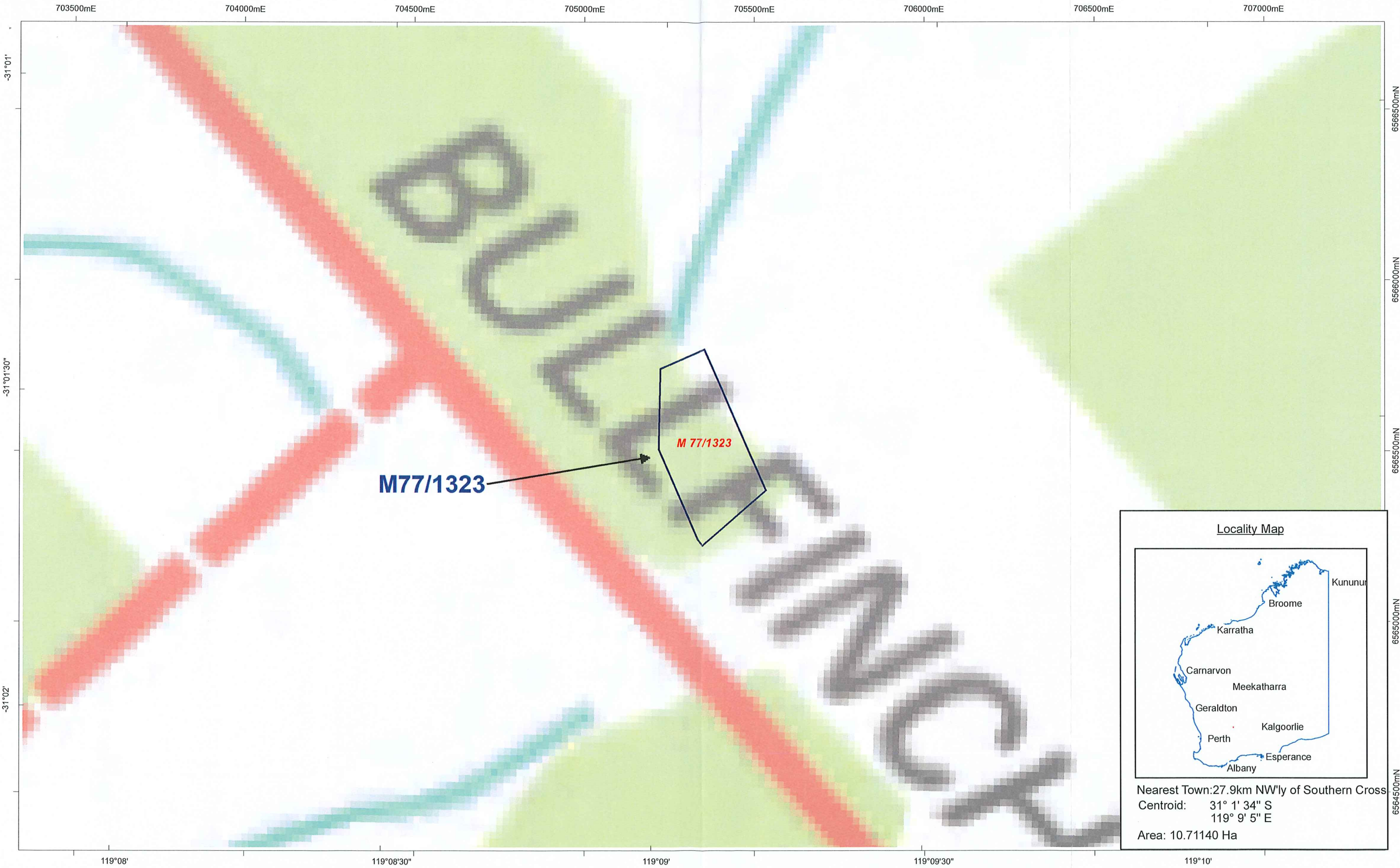
