In accordance with section 29(2) of the Commonwealth Native Title Act 1993 (Cth) (NTA) the Department of Mines, Petroleum and Exploration (DMPE) provides this notice and a plan showing the location of lease/licence application/s that under the Mining Act 1978 (WA) may be granted over land and/or waters in respect of which you are a native title representative body. Arrangements have been made to publish this notice newspapers (including newspapers catering mainly or exclusively for the interests of Aboriginal peoples or Torres Strait Islanders).

DMPE considers that the grant of the lease/licence is a future act that attracts the expedited procedure pursuant to section 32(1) of the NTA. The expedited procedure applies if the grant of the lease/licence in relation to land or waters concerned is an act not likely to:

- interfere directly with the carrying on of the community or social activities of the persons who are holders of the native title in relation to the land or waters concerned;
- interfere with areas or sites of particular significance, in accordance with the traditions of the persons who are holders of the native title in relation to the land or waters concerned; and



involve major disturbance to any land or waters concerned or create rights whose exercise is likely to involve major disturbance to any land or waters concerned.

In accordance with section 29(4)(a) of the NTA DMPE hereby advises that the "notification day" is 8 October 2025.

Under section 30(1)(a) of the NTA, any person who is a registered native title claimant in relation to any of the land and/or waters that will be affected by the act becomes a native title party and is entitled to procedural rights in accordance with the NTA. A native title party may, within the period of four months after the notification day lodge an objection with the National Native Title Tribunal (NNTT) against the inclusion of the expedited statement in the notice. The four-month period closes on 8 February 2026.

The NNTT will in due course advise the parties as to whether a native title party has lodged an objection to the expedited procedure within the four-month period.

If no objection is lodged then the lease/licence application can be granted. If an objection is lodged the NNTT will hold an inquiry to determine whether the act is an act attracting the expedited procedure. In the latter event the NNTT will advise you of the procedures that must be followed by the parties.

Nature of the Act: Grant of prospecting licences which authorises the applicant to prospect for minerals for a term of 4 years from date of grant. Grant of exploration licences, which authorises the applicant to explore for minerals for a term of 5 years from the date of grant.


Notification Day: 8 October 2025

Native Title Parties: Under section 30 of the *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)*, persons have until 3 months after the notification day to take certain steps to become native title parties in relation to applications. The 3 month period closes on 8 January 2026. Any person who is, or becomes a native title party, is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2 Division 3 Subdivision P of *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)*. Enquiries in relation to filing a native title determination application to become a native title party should be directed to the Federal Court of Australia, 1 Victoria Avenue, Perth WA 6000, telephone (08) 9268 7100.

Expedited Procedure: The State of Western Australia considers that these acts are acts attracting the expedited procedure. Each licence may be granted unless, within the period of 4 months after the notification day (i.e. 8 February 2026), a native title party lodges an objection with the National Native Title Tribunal against the inclusion of the statement that the State considers the grant of the licence is an act attracting the expedited procedure. 



E 15/2106 Native Title Act 1993 (Cth) Notification Plan











P 26/4849 Native Title Act 1993 (Cth) Notification Plan




