The purposes of L 15/496 are: a communications facility, a fuel storage facility, a minesite accommodation facility, a minesite administration facility, a pipeline, a power generation and transmission facility, a power line, a pump station, a road, a water management facility, a workshop and storage facility

You are hereby notified in your capacity as a registered native title claimant, native title body corporate or a representative Aboriginal Torres Strait Islander Body that application has been made for the tenement/s listed for the sole purpose of the construction of an infrastructure facility associated with mining (as defined in Section 253 of the Commonwealth *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)* (NTA)) for an initial term of 21 years. I would also inform you that subject to the completion of any relevant processing under the Mining Act 1978 (WA) and Section 24MD(6B) under the NTA that there is an intention that the licence/lease be granted.

Plan/s showing the location of the application(s) is/are enclosed.

In accordance with Section 24MD(6B)(d) any registered native title claimant or registered native title body corporate may object within two months of notification, to the grant of the licence/lease by **14 January 2026** so far as it affects their registered native title rights and interests in relation to land or waters to which the lease/licence relates.

The licence/lease applicant must consult any registered native title claimants and native title bodies corporate who object, about ways of minimising the impact of the grant of the licence/lease on registered native title rights and interests in relation to the land or waters. If relevant the applicant must also consult about any access to the land or the way in which anything authorised by the grant of the lease/licence might be done.

Any objection lodged by a registered native title claimant or by a registered native title body corporate is to be in the form of a letter addressed to or delivered to the General Manager Resource Access, Locked Bag 100, East Perth WA 6892 and must be received before the close of business at 4.30pm on **14 January 2026**. The objection must contain the following information:

- number of the Miscellaneous licence/General Purpose lease objected to;
- details of how the grant of the licence/lease will affect the objector's registered native title rights and interests in relation to the land or waters affected; and
- the name, claim number and address for service of the registered native title claimant or registered native title body corporate

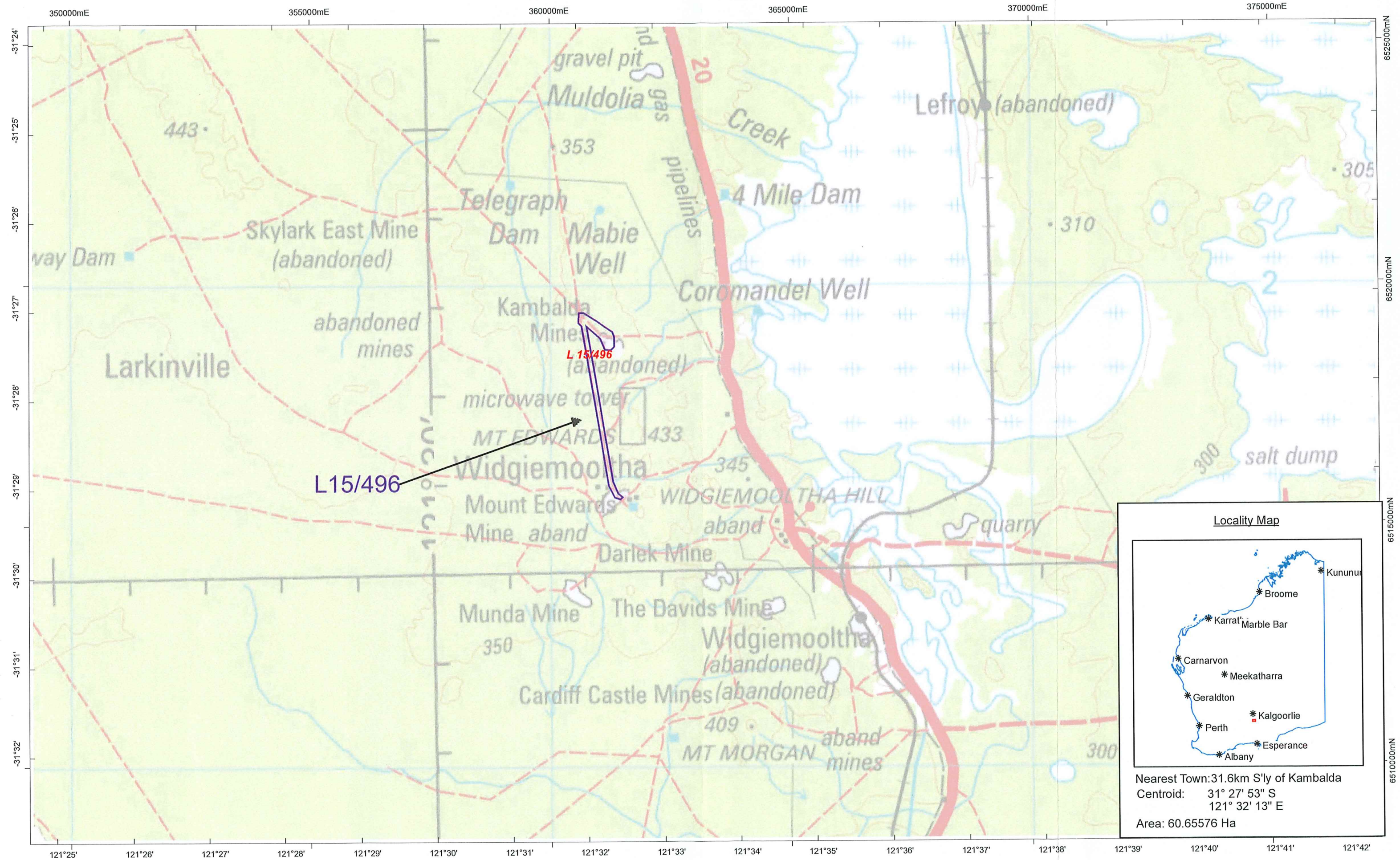

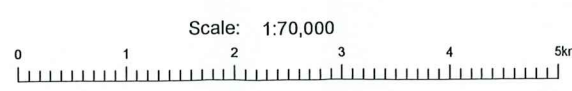
L 15/496 Native Title Act 1993 (Cth) Notification Plan
