Background

NTS Goldfields (**NTSG**) are holding an information and consultation workshop to discuss native title research, and a potential new native title claim over the area shown in the following map. This is for an area around Agnew and Lawlers, extending south around Poison Creek and west around Munjeroo. This meeting follows on from consultation and research that has been conducted by NTSG over the past few years.

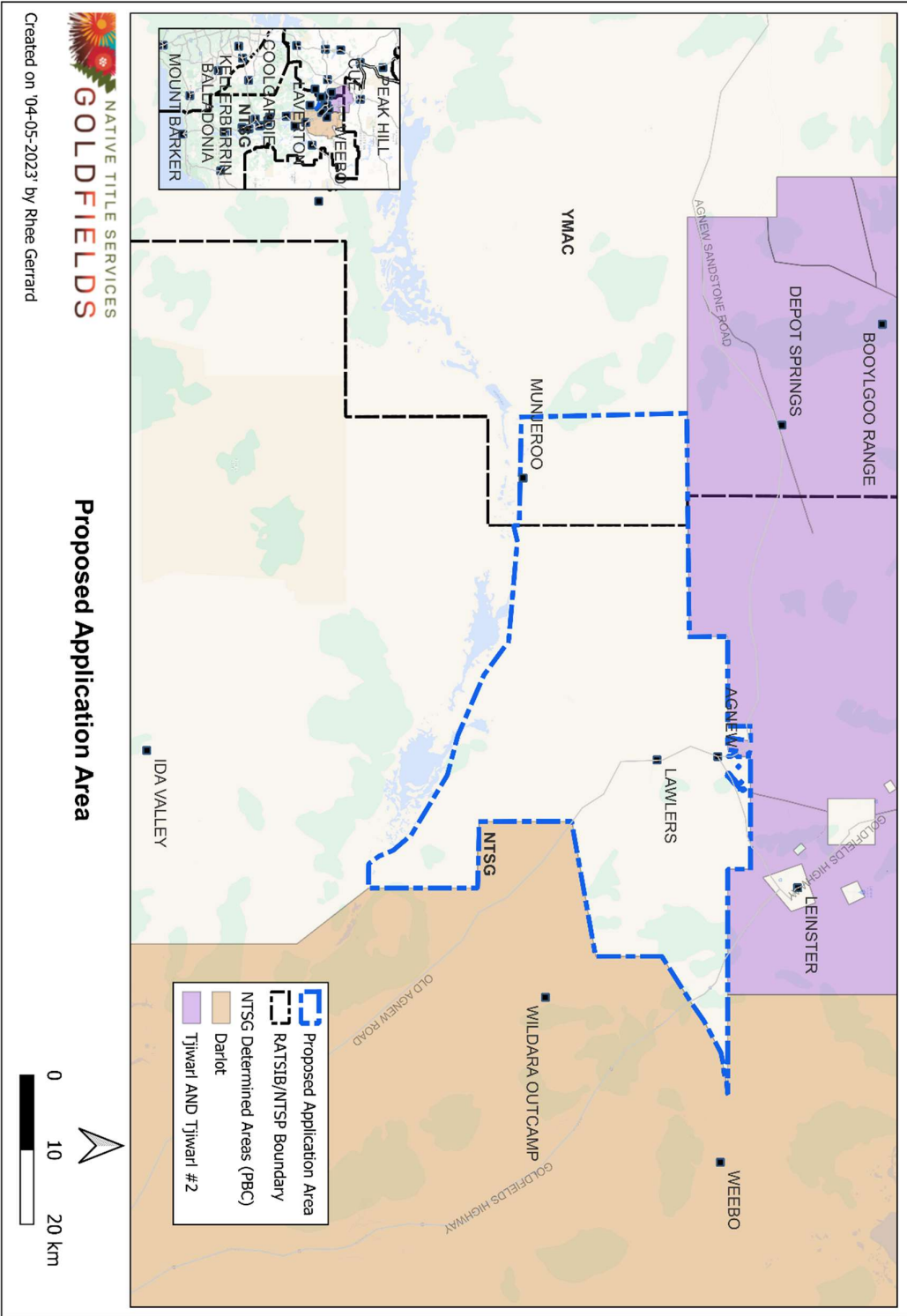
The purpose of this workshop is to:

1. provide an update on the research for the purpose of a proposed native title claim over the area, including discussing who the potential native title holders may be;
2. discuss the traditional laws and customs which govern the exercise of native title rights and interests in the area; and
3. discuss next steps for the making of a native title claimant application.

TRAVEL ASSISTANCE FOR AGNEW WORKSHOP

If you live more than 50km from a meeting, you may be eligible for Travel Assistance. Travel Assistance is calculated at a rate of c \$0.40/km (return trip) up to a maximum of \$400 total. This payment is a contribution to your costs for fuel, food and accommodation and is not intended to cover the full cost of your attendance.

Conditions

- You must attend most of the workshop, signing in and out at the start and end of the day.
- Forms are provided at the end of the workshop to eligible attendees.
- If driving, you must provide a valid driver's licence and vehicle registration. This will be confirmed by staff after the workshop. Anyone without a valid driver's licence or car registration is not eligible for payment.
- Payment is per car, not per person.
- Payment is based on the distance from your home address and the venue, not necessarily where you have travelled from.

Payments

- Payments are made after the workshop once attendance and details are checked.
- Payments may take up to 5 business days.
- Please ensure you provide the correct licence, vehicle registration and bank details as errors will cause delays.
- For this workshop, NTSG will also contribute \$100 for accommodation for attendees who live more than 200km away from the meeting venue.
- To apply for this additional assistance, you will need to provide a booking confirmation or a receipt from the accommodation.
- NTSG is unable to make bookings on your behalf.
- There is limited accommodation available in Leinster so please book early.

- You may be able to get additional help from other organisations, but you must contact them directly.

Financial Hardship

- You can apply for an advance payment of Travel Assistance if your financial circumstances make it impossible for you to attend otherwise.
