Background

The purpose of this meeting is to consider and make decisions in relation to the proposed consent determination of native title for the Tjalkadjara native title claim (WAD 597 of 2018). The matters to be discussed include the authorisation of the Minute of Consent Determination of Native Title and the authorisation and nomination of a corporation to be the Prescribed Body Corporate for the Tjalkadjara native title holding group.

Purpose

Progress and finalisation of the Claimant Application:

1. To **consider advice, discuss and make decisions about** amendments to:
 - a) Include “Dimple Sullivan” and “Charlie Winter” as additional ancestors, so that descendants of those ancestors are included as persons comprising the Tjalkadjara native title claim group for the purposes of a consent determination; and
 - b) discrepancies between the Tjalkadjara native title claim group description and the description of native title holders in the proposed Minute of Consent Determination of Native Title;
2. To **authorise** the proposed Final Minute of Consent Determination of native title for the Tjalkadjara native title determination application (WAD 597 of 2018), including authorising

the description of native title holders to be included in that Minute; and

3. To **consider advice, discuss and make decisions about** the incorporation of a Prescribed Body Corporate (PBC) for the Tjalkadjara native title consent determination.

Pre-incorporation & nomination of PBC

4. To **authorise** the incorporation of a corporation proposed to be the PBC for the Tjalkadjara native title holding group.
5. To **elect and authorise** the initial directors of a corporation proposed to be the PBC.
6. To **appoint and authorise** the contact person for the corporation proposed to be the PBC.
7. To **authorise the nomination** of the corporation as the PBC for the Tjalkadjara native title consent determination.

A. Members of the Tjalkadjara native title claim group are invited to attend. Persons who are members of the Tjalkadjara claim are those persons included in the following claim group description:

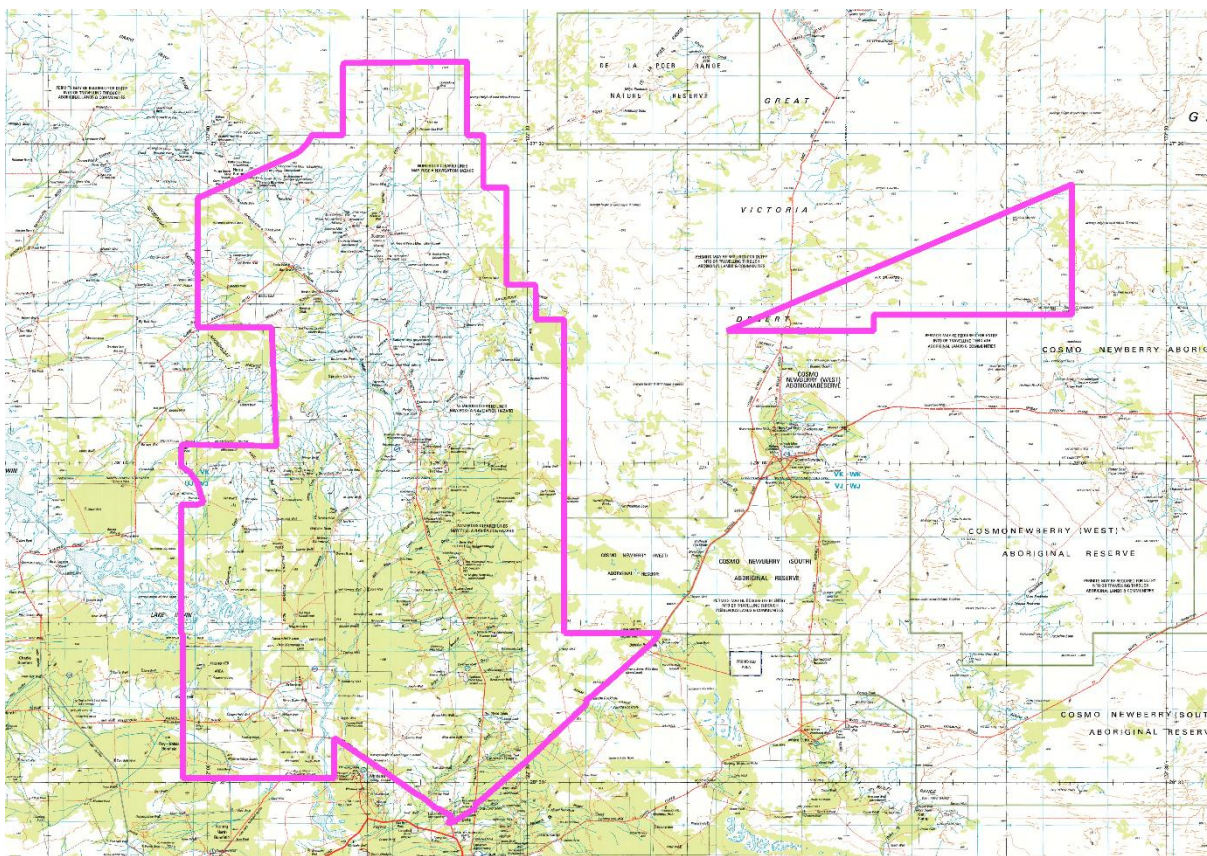
1. *The native title claim group comprises the persons who hold native title rights and interests in the claim area through one or more of the following:*
 - (a) *their own birth or the birth of an ancestor on the claim area; or*
 - (b) *their own or an ancestor's long association with the claim area; or*
 - (c) *having religious, sacred or ritual authority for land within the claim area;**and who have a connection with the claim area in accordance with traditional laws and customs.*
2. *As at the date of this application, the persons referred to in (a) above include the descendants of the following persons who had a connection with the claim area in accordance with traditional laws and customs:*
 - (a) *Wunu and his wife Biyuwara (Biddy);*
 - (b) *Narangkatu (father of Biman, Thati and Dinah);*
 - (c) *Pangu (father of Scotty Lewis);*
 - (d) *Annie Green Tuteru / Tuthara;*
 - (e) *Tom Wunal;*
 - (f) *Tharin and his wife Ruby Daga (parents of Nguldard Jim Hennesy and others);*
 - (g) *Lily Wongawol;*
 - (h) *Ngaratarikartaly Nellie Warren and her husbands Munggi Munggi and Ngawila;*
 - (i) *Turada Skipper Sandy and Paddy Tjintjarti;*
 - (j) *Billy Kubuludanu (Billy Polak);*
 - (k) *Walaainga and Tjiku Tjiku;*
 - (l) *Marnupa and Billy Campbell;*
 - (m) *Thatijarra Banks and Paddy Longfellow Banks;*
 - (n) *Nukuwarra Paddy Bond and Nyultan Polly Mitchell;*
 - (o) *Waltila Snowy Westlake and Nganuma;*

Code of Conduct

Attendees are required to comply with NTSG’s Code of Conduct to participate in the meeting.

Shouting, swearing, insulting, continuous interruptions, or verbally or physically aggressive behaviour will not be tolerated. Violence of any kind will not be tolerated. Travel Assistance

Travel assistance is not intended to reimburse constituents for the entire cost of attending the meeting, rather it is to contribute towards the cost of attending meetings.

Constituents who live over 50kms away from where the meeting is held may be eligible for travel assistance to help cover some of the costs incurred. Travel assistance is calculated at a rate of \$0.40/km, capped at a maximum of \$400 for a return trip.

To receive assistance, constituents must be present for most of the meeting, demonstrated by signing in at the start of the meeting and signing out at the close of the meeting, at the registration desk. Travel assistance forms will only be made available at the conclusion of the meeting and only to those persons who have been present for most of the meeting.

If travelling by car, constituents must provide valid drivers' license details and provide their vehicle license plate number when signing in for the meeting. NTSG is unable to pay travel assistance if the driver's license or vehicle registration is not valid.

If constituents travel by car, travel assistance is paid per car, not per individual/passenger.

Travel assistance will be paid from NTSG's bank account after the meeting has ended and may take up to 5 business days to be processed.
