In accordance with section 29(2) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (the Act) the Department of Mines, Petroleum and Exploration (DMPE) provides this notice and a plan showing the location of the mining lease/s that under section 78(2) of the *Mining Act 1978* may be renewed, over land and/or waters in respect of which you are a representative Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander body, [see s 29(2)(b)(ii) of the Act].

Arrangements have been made to publish this notice in newspapers (including newspapers catering mainly or exclusively for the [interests](#) of [Aboriginal peoples](#) or [Torres Strait Islanders](#)).

DEMIRS hereby advises that the "notification day" is **3 June 2026**. This date is given in accordance with section 29(4)(a) of the Act.

Under section 30(1)(a) of the Act, persons have until 3 months after the notification day to take certain steps to become native title parties in relation to the notice. The 3-month period closes on **3 September 2026**. Any person who is, or becomes a native title party, is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2 Division 3 Subdivision P of the Act.

If there is no native title party at the end of the four months after the notification day (i.e. **3 October 2026**) then the mining lease/s may be renewed.

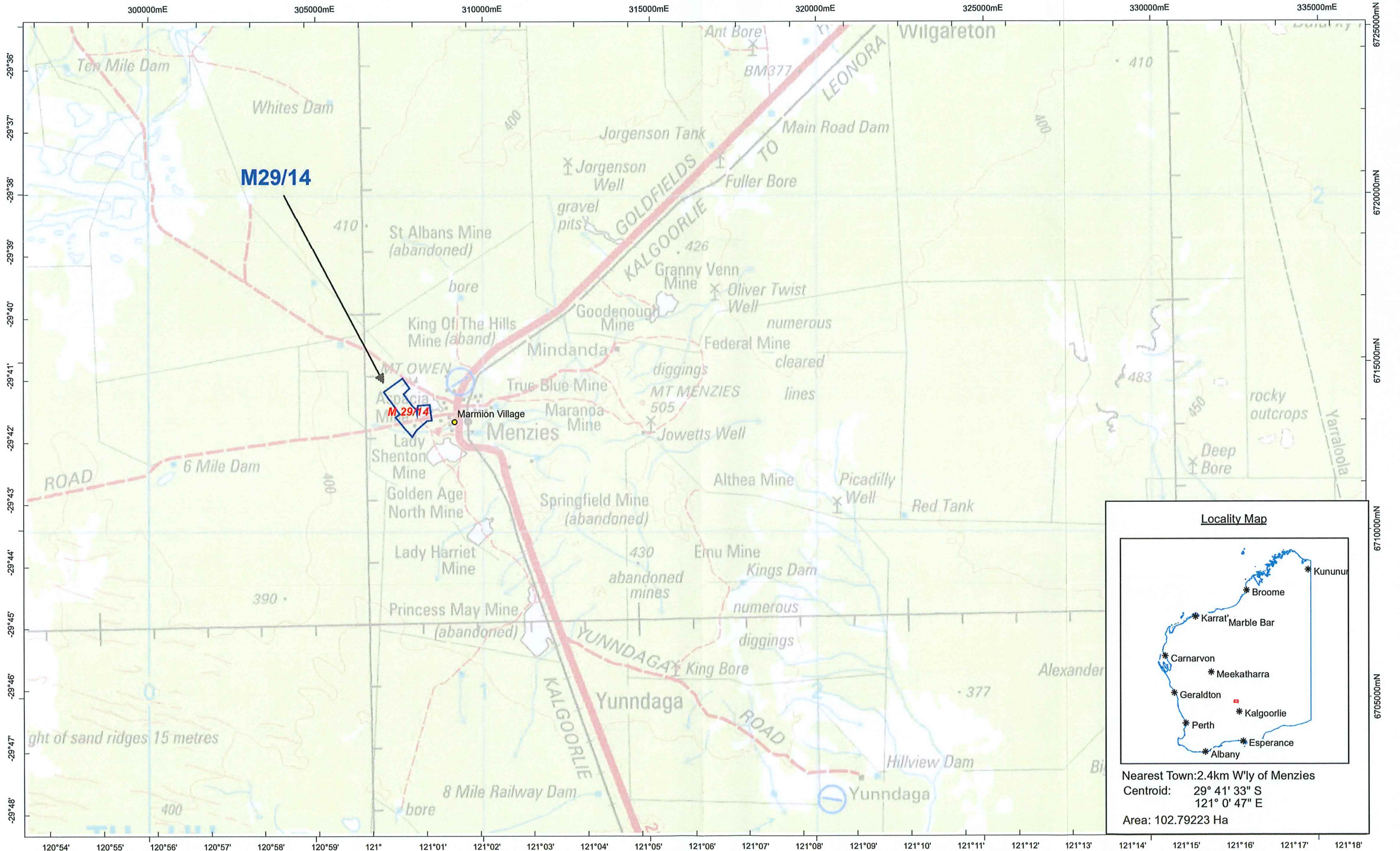
Nature of the act: The renewal of mining lease, which authorises the applicant to mine for minerals for a term of up to 21 years.

Notification day: 3 June 2026

Native title parties: Under section 30 of the *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)*, persons have until three months after the notification day to take certain steps to become native title parties in relation to the notice. The three-month period closes on **3 September 2026**. Any person who is, or becomes a native title party, is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2 Division 3 Subdivision P of *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)*. Enquiries in relation to filing a native title determination application to become a native title party should be directed to the Federal Court of Australia, 1 Victoria Avenue, Perth WA 6000, telephone (08) 9268 7100. The mining lease may be renewed if, by the end of the period of four months after the notification day (i.e. **3 October 2026**), there is no native title party under section 30 of the *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)* in relation to the area of the application for renewal.
