NTS Goldfields Ltd (NTSG) is convening information and consultation sessions in Kalgoorlie and Leonora to discuss a proposed authorisation meeting being held in Menzies on 21 September. The proposed authorisation meeting, advertised by Umanity Group, has been brought to NTSG's attention, and NTSG has been receiving queries from constituents about it. Staff will be available at the above locations, during the notified times to meet with interested people.

The area of the proposed claim for which the authorisation meeting is being convened is set out in the map below.

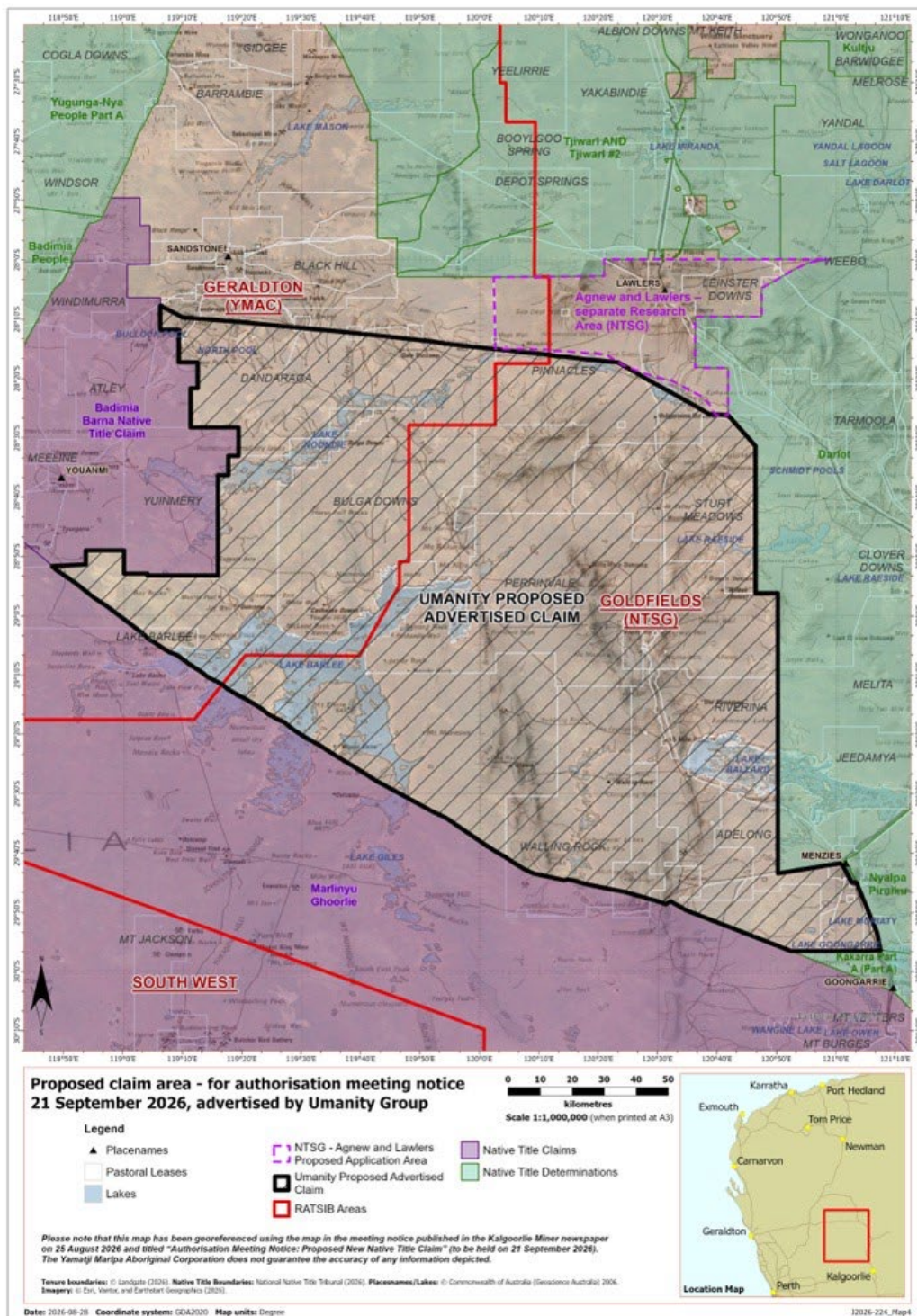
